Infrastructure – Enabling Technologies – Business Model Description

Companies which provide technology to enable development of artificial intelligence based applications or platform. Includes companies providing software for improved data collection/preparation. Also includes companies providing specialized hardware like processors for faster processing.

Software

Companies providing solutions for data extraction, data preparation, data training, etc. to be used by Machine Intelligence Systems. Also, includes companies providing platform or workbench for AI application development.



Hardware

Companies providing specialized hardware like processor, electronic systems which accelerate the processing power for machine learning/ deep learning inference and training






Infrastructure - Machine Intelligence Systems - Business Model Description

Companies which provide cloud-hosted platforms, APIs or libraries for machine learning and deep learning. Also includes companies developing algorithms which can demonstrate Artificial General Intelligence (AGI)

Machine Learning

Companies providing Machine Learning platforms, APIs, libraries that can learn from and make predictions on data



Deep Learning

Companies providing deep learning based platform which will help in implementing techniques such as convolutional multi-layer neural networks, deep neural networks



Cognitive Learning

Companies providing platform or infrastructure for building general purpose algorithms based on the concepts of cognitive sciences, human problem-solving skills and operation research.






Infrastructure – Computer Vision – Business Model Description

Companies providing platforms to analyse the visual content of an image or a video as well as recognize and classify object within an image/video. Also, includes companies providing technologies for facial expression recognition and behavior / emotion analytics

Computer vision platform

Companies providing general purpose platform to develop applications for different computer vision use cases like object recognition, face recognition, image processing, etc.



Object Recognition

Companies providing platform which can recognize or tag or caption objects from images and videos



Face Recognition

Companies providing a platform for facial expression recognition and behavior/emotion analytics solutions for use cases in security, retail, healthcare, etc.





Infrastructure - Natural Language Processing - Business Model Description

Companies providing infrastructure which enables machines to recognize and process speech / text and generate natural language based insights from data. Also, includes companies providing solutions for conversation systems.

NLP Platforms

Companies providing generalpurpose NLP platforms for speech or text related solutions





Speech Solutions

Companies providing platforms, APIs, framework, etc. for speech related solutions like automatics speech recognition (ASR), speech analytics and speech to text conversations



Text Solutions

Companies providing platforms, APIs, framework, etc. for text related solutions like text analytics, automatic language translation, and others









Conversational Al

Companies providing technology enablers to develop conversational systems












Cumulative funding in the sector







